
This is in response to your request under the Freedom of Information Act dated 30 April 2007. Therein you requested from the U.S. Central Command records concerning a complete photograph of the Misagh-1 MANPADS missile and the power point presentation entitled "Iranian Support for Lethal Activity in Iraq". The U.S. Central Command located one document responsive to the request and referred it to the Defense Intelligence Agency for our review and direct response to you.

Upon review, it has been determined that all substantive portions of the document are not releasable. The withheld portions are exempt from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552 (b)(1), (b)(2), and (b)(3), Freedom of Information Act. Subsection (b)(1) applies to information properly classified under the criteria provided by Executive Order 12958, as amended. Subsection (b)(2) applies to information which pertains solely to the internal rules and practices of the agency. Subsection (b)(3) applies to information specifically exempted by a statute establishing particular criteria for withholding. The applicable statute is 10 U.S.C. Section 424. There are no reasonably segregable portions of this exempt material.

You are advised that a requester may appeal, within 60 days, an initial decision to withhold a record or part thereof. Should you wish to exercise this right, you may do so by referring to case #0480-2007 and addressing your appeal to:
