IT IS **FURTHER ORDERED** that by no later than <u>9:00 AM on September 27, 2013</u>, the Government shall provide the Court with unredacted versions of the pages that comprise Exhibit 8 to the Defendant's Fifth Motion to Compel for *in camera* review by the Court. If the documents are only available on a read and return basis, the Government shall arrange for the documents to be provided to Chambers at 9:00 AM on Monday, September 30, 2013.
