App. III (hereinafter CIPA or "the Act"), has designated the Assistant Attorney General, National Security Division, to exercise or perform the functions and duties conferred upon the Attorney General and the Deputy Attorney General by the Act.

3. I submit this certification pursuant to Sections 6(a) and 6(c) of CIPA, which authorize me, as the Assistant Attorney General, to request that a hearing be held <u>in camera</u> and that the transcript of the <u>in camera</u> hearing be sealed.

4. The matters stated herein are based upon my knowledge, upon review and consideration of documents and information available to me in my official capacity as Assistant

Attorney General, and discussions that I have had with other officials of the Department of Justice.

5. The Government has requested a hearing in this case pursuant to CIPA Sections 6(a) and 6(c) so that the Court can conduct a hearing to make all determinations concerning the use, relevance, or admissibility of classified information that would otherwise be made during trial or a pretrial hearing.

6. CIPA Section 6 provides that this hearing shall be held <u>in camera</u> at the request of the Attorney General or his designee if the Attorney General or his designee certifies that a public proceeding may result in the disclosure of classified information.

7. As the Attorney General's designee, I certify that a public hearing on this matter may result in the disclosure of classified information which is the subject of the Government's motion.

8. Therefore, I respectfully request that this hearing be held <u>in camera</u>, pursuant to Sections 6(a) and 6(c) of CIPA and that the transcript of the <u>in camera</u> hearing be sealed.
